Application for Enrollment 2022-2023 School Year

Dear Parents and Guardians:

Thank you for your interest in Sherman Indian High School as the place for your high school student to receive their education. Since 1902, Sherman has been offering educational opportunities for students from all parts of the United States, and the 22-23 school year will see us return to our normal operations. As we continue to transition from the Covid pandemic, please know that we have the safety of your student at the forefront of everything we do.

As we work to process your students' application, allow me to offer a few tips and reminders:


- The first page is a check off page. Please use this page to keep track of your progress in completing the application.
- In order for your student to start the school year on time, all documents need to be submitted no later than July 15, 2022. Failure to meet this deadline may cause your student to miss part of the school year and/or have them placed on a waiting list for second semester.
- Please include your students name at the top of each page of the application.
- Please make sure that all requested information and documents are attached to your student's application before submitting it. Missing pages hold up approval.
- **Falsification or withholding of any information in this application will be grounds for non-acceptance or immediate dismissal.**
- The Admissions Committee will review every application and notify each applicant by phone or mail as to the status of his or her application. Sending all requested information the first time will help the Admissions Committee process your application quicker.
- If you should have any questions, please contact the Registrar Office at (951) 276-6326 ext. 382.
- The following items tend to be difficult to obtain, but are required for processing of your student's application:
 - ✓ Current physical (please schedule as soon as possible);
 - ✓ Current immunizations and records;
 - ✓ Certificate of Indian Blood (CIB);
 - ✓ Middle school Promotion Certificate, 7th and 8th grade report cards, and test scores (Incoming 9th graders only)

Once your student is accepted, here are some items to keep in mind about the start of the school year:

- We are scheduled to begin classes on August 29th.
- August 20th – 26th is our Welcome Back Week. Students will have an opportunity to get to know the campus, get their laptop and class schedule, and make friends during this week.
- It is **absolutely important** that your student travel on the day we have scheduled for you. Failure to travel on your assigned day may cause your student to miss the beginning of the school year or be placed on a waiting list for second semester.
- Travel is tentatively scheduled for the week of August 15th – 19th.
- Travel will be provided for each student at the beginning of the school year, round trip for winter break, and at the end of the school year.
- Any withdrawals or emergency travel will be the responsibility of the parent/guardian.
- Students will need the REAL ID for airline travel beginning on May 3, 2023. Since this is federally mandated, please apply for your student's REAL ID as soon as possible, as this will affect their travel home at the end of the school year in May 2023.

Thank you again for your interest and confidence in Sherman Indian High School for your child's education and we look forward to meeting your student in August!
